#### PRODUCT-MARKET FIT

Product-market fit, a well-established concept in the startup world, refers to the moment when a product perfectly meets the expectations of its target market, thus achieving real success with its users.

#### DISTRACTED LEMMINGS...

A persistent myth claims that lemmings—small rodents living in Arctic regions—commit mass suicide by throwing themselves off cliffs during migrations. This idea was widely disseminated by the 1958 Disney documentary White Wilderness. However, scientists have debunked this myth: lemmings do not commit suicide. Deaths observed during their migrations are actually due to exhaustion or extreme weather conditions.

#### SASS

Spyware-as-a-Service (SASS) is a criminal service allowing users to rent spyware to discreetly steal data. With SAAS, the cyber-attacker depends on a provider for the software.

#### IF YOU CAN'T LARP YOU'LL CRY

#### RASS

Ransomware-as-a-Service (RASS) is a service providing turnkey ransomware (malware that blocks access to a computer or encrypts files) to demand a ransom. RASS flips the dynamic: the attacker becomes autonomous, directly acquiring the software and personally demanding the ransom.



#### THE COWHERD AND THE WEAVER





#### DO YOU TAKE GREEN POISON OR PURPLE POISON?


It's a visual code shared by video games: a green or purple vial means it's a poison. It's possible to collect some to contaminate your opponents.


#### SLIME
